Nottingham has confirmed that it is looking to bid for European Capital of Culture 2023.

The announcement took place in a spectacular luminarium – a structure of luminescent colour and light – created by internationally re-

nowned local artists Architects of Air. Competing against Belfast, Dundee, Leeds, and Milton Keynes, Nottingham's European Capital of Culture 2023 bid team is confident Nottingham's entry will be heavily supported by people across the Midlands and beyond, and is calling on locals to become Nottingham 2023 'Cultural Lions'.

Paul Russ, Chairman of Nottingham's Cultural Strategy Partnership and Chair of the Nottingham 2023 board said: "The lions outside the Council

House have been a local meeting, gathering and rallying point for decades, we are a proud and inclusive city and urge people of all backgrounds to 'join our pride' and help us get to the next stage of the bid by becoming Cultural Lions. "Nottingham is an ambitious, young and diverse city with a culture of grassroots collaboration and a history of rebellious innovation.

"As part of the bid, we want to give everyone in Nottingham the opportunity to take part in a project, production or experience and nurture the next generation of creative producers and cultural

people in their community. The Children's Centres run by Nottinghamshire Children and Families Partnership, a partnership between Nottinghamshire Healthcare, Family Action and North Nottinghamshire College, applied for a grant earlier this year to fund the project. The 'Big Day Out' project includes a five-week preparation family learning course for local families, leading to an outing to Sherwood Pines Forest Park available to the wider community, thereby creating a sense of unity across the community and peer support amongst local families. The course will focus on strategies for coping with children

throughout holiday periods, cheap and easy play ideas, as well as improving adults' confidence in learning. Michelle Squires, Community Development Worker for Hucknall Children's Centre was delighted to hear they had won and said:

"Lots of families find it difficult to have an affordable day out with their children and aren't aware of free, local places to go. Some families also often struggle to think of

cheap and easy ways to keep their children busy during holiday periods and this funding will help families to gain new skills whilst bringing together the local community."

Three groups in every Tesco region were shortlisted to receive cash awards for local projects that bring benefits to the community. The Tesco initiative is a community grant scheme where money raised by the 5p bag charge funds local community projects.

“We’re proposing a ‘cultural change’ programme that will transform the lives of people in the Midlands; harnessing the power of creativity, stimulating innovation, attracting investment and creating new international networks that will redefine our relationship to Europe and the world.”
Nottingham has one of the youngest and most diverse populations in the UK, with an average age of just 34. Spearheading the Nottingham 2023 bid is Nottingham’s Strategic Cultural Partnership, with support provided by Nottingham City Council,

the University of Nottingham, Nottingham Trent University and Marketing NG.
Professor Edward Peck, Vice-Chancellor of Nottingham Trent University said: “Nottingham Trent has a proud 175-year history of contributing to the cultural and economic development of the region, so we are delighted to be backing the bid and the enormous opportunities that being capital of culture will bring to the City and County.”
The city and surrounding county has a history of pioneering new ways of thinking and working together, from the legend

of Robin Hood, computing pioneer Ada Lovelace, and the writings of DH Lawrence, Alan Sillitoe and Jon McGregor, to the work of fashion designer Sir Paul Smith, singer-songwriter Jake Bugg, and nationally celebrated theatre makers Adam Penford, Emma Rice and Jenny Sealey.
The European Capital of Culture programme is an annual competition in which cities from two selected European countries bid for the title. In 2023 both the UK and Hungary will host a European Capital of Culture. Nottingham has until 27 October 2017 to produce its bid.

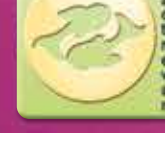

Grateful Father Thanks Hospital for Saving Son's Life

The grateful family of a baby, who doctors feared may not survive, have written to thank Nottingham Children's Hospital for saving his life as he reaches his first birthday.

Alex McQueen was JUST two weeks old when he was admitted to Nottingham Children's Hospital in August last year suffering from meningitis.

He was transferred from Good Hope Hospital in Birmingham and his condition was so serious that his parents were warned to expect the worst.

Paediatric Consultant at Nottingham University Hospital, Charlotte Good-volk said: "When Alex was admitted we weren't sure he would make it through the night. "By morning he had stabilised and improved enough to come off the ventilator but we were still concerned he would have serious long term health problems."

Alex has gone on to defy doctors' predictions and is now a healthy one-year-old, after celebrating his first birthday on the 28th July.

His dad Martin said: "My wife Lindsey and I have always said that without the support from Charlotte and her team he wouldn't have survived the first night. They have given us the best gift anyone has ever

given.

"After he was released from QMC he went back to Birmingham for a week, and since then he seems to have made it his business to prove he can do all of the things we were told he would never be able to do. We really think we have witnessed a miracle. He's turning in to such a little monkey. He's mastered crawling, is now close to

walking and is eating us out of house and home."

Father and Son Lead the Way with Social Housing 'Ultra Site'



A father and son team is playing a key role in building new social housing for Nottingham City Homes as Robert Woodhead builds 39 new homes to deliver Ultra Site.

Mark Hackleton, Site Manager with Robert Woodhead Ltd, is leading a team at the former Morley School site in St Ann's that includes his 19-year-old son, Tyler. The site, the only social housing considerate constructors scheme (CCS) Ultra Site in the UK, is part of the Building a Better Nottingham programme that is creating more affordable homes for local families across the city.

The CCS accredits sites which show they are taking into consideration the local environment, the surrounding community, working conditions and facilities for those working on site, and training and employment opportunities for local residents. Ultra Site

status is given to sites that go above and beyond the basic expectations of the CCS.

"A key part of being designated an Ultra Site is boosting employment, training and work experience opportunities," said Mark. "My son, Tyler, and many other young people from the local area have been benefitting from working on site, getting an insight into what it's like to work in the construction industry and developing their own skills."

"We also have 12 apprentices on site, and we're supporting local labour and supply chain providers, using around 20 different sub-contractors across plumbing, electrics, painting, joinery, tiling and roofing."

Mark's son Tyler, who has been working on site since last November and is undertaking a Construction and Built Environment Level 3 Ap-

prenticeship, feels he has benefitted enormously from working alongside his dad. He said: "Working with dad has been great - he has lots of experience, so I've been able to learn a lot from him. He treats me just like everyone else on site, so he doesn't go easy on me."

Philippa McKenna, Senior Development Manager at Nottingham City Homes, said: "It's wonderful to see these new bungalows and family homes transforming the local area, but the wider community benefits are just as important. Work experience placements, apprenticeship opportunities and the use of local businesses are providing a very important boost for the local economy."

When completed, the former Morley School site will include nine three-bed houses, 24 two-bed houses and six bungalows.

It is the biggest free to watch sporting event on the calendar, and the first stage to ever be hosted by Nottinghamshire.

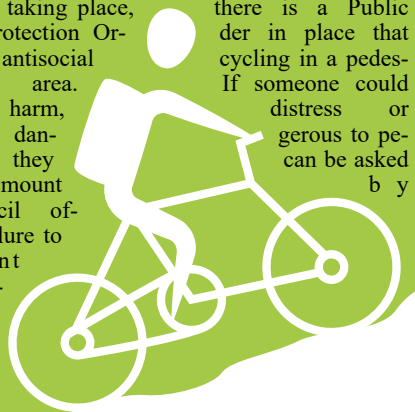

Councillor Dave Saunders, Portfolio Holder for Regeneration and Growth, said: "We expect it to be very busy so please take care wherever you decide to see the race. In the town centre there will be bike racks available for cyclists' convenience and we would encourage them to dismount and push their bikes through the pedestrianised areas in crowded spots for the safety of others."

On a normal day when a special event such as this isn't taking place, there is a Public Space Protection Order in place that prohibits antisocial cycling in a pedestrianised area.

If someone could cause harm, distress or become dangerous to pedestrians they could be asked to dismount a council officer. Failure to dismount could result in a fine.

More Volunteers Needed To Meet Demand

Newark Community First Aid is seeking more volunteers to meet the growing demand for its services.

Last year saw the charity attend 388 local events, an increase of 17% on the previous year.

Jonathan Brown NCFA's Events Manager said "We are pleased that so many local events use our services, we aim to provide a quality service and feedback from organisers shows that we are rated highly.

"However, we have had to turn down events in the peak summer months as we quickly booked up on some dates – we would like to be able to meet all requests but need more volunteers".

The charity provides first aid cover to events in Newark and the villages in the surrounding 14-miles radius. All types

of events are covered, in the last few weeks events as diverse as religious festivals, netball, Tech Fest – a rock music event, antique fairs, the Robin Hood Festival, agricultural shows and horse events have kept the volunteers busy.

Philip Jessop, NCFA Training Manager, said: "Becoming a volunteer is a great way of meeting people and learning new skills combined with the satisfaction of being able to help people who become ill or injured.

"We welcome trained first aiders, but you do not need to have training or experience to join, as we provide a comprehensive training package. Membership

is open to anyone over 16

years of age; it is ideal training for young people interested in a career in health or childcare."

At the moment the charity has 60 volunteers but needs at least another 20. Full training is provided, weekly meetings/training sessions are held on Monday evenings at the Newark Academy on London Road at Balderton near Newark.

All volunteers are fully insured and provided with a uniform. As well as training in first aid a range of other training is provided in areas such as health and safety, safeguarding, moving and handling and infection control.

Volunteers once trained can choose which events to attend, as clearly work and family life have to be considered.

The charity will be holding recruitment events & drop in training sessions for the public in the Butter Market in Newark Market Place on Fri 25th and Wed 30th August and Fri 22nd and Wed 27th September.

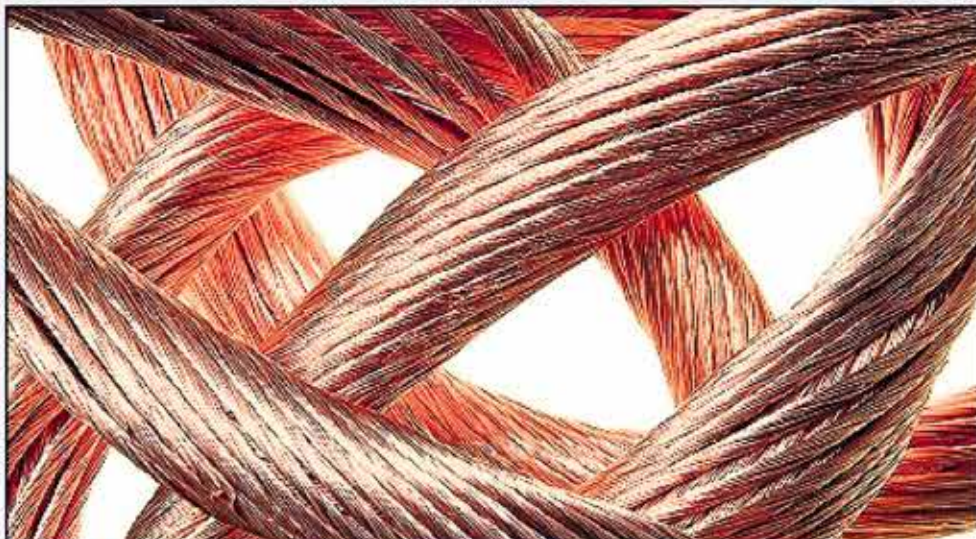
