

Nottinghamshire Healthcare has officially opened a 16 bedded ward for adult mental health patients to ensure they can be treated closer to home

The beds have been subcontracted to the Trust from Priory Healthcare and Partnerships in Care, in a two year-deal and will be used by adults requiring inpatient mental health treatment. This new partnership will ensure that more patients can receive inpatient care locally, supported by our community services. Having further acute beds in Nottinghamshire will also allow families, friends and carers to have easier access when visiting their loved ones, ensuring their participation in their care and recovery.

The Trust took control of Bestwood Ward at the Calverton Hill facility on 1 August and the official opening was held this week. Calverton Hill, in Arnold, is a medium secure unit for adults with mental illness or personality disorders.

Bestwood Ward has been refurbished to create a normal acute ward suitable for our patients. Ruth Hawkins, Chief Executive at Nottinghamshire

Healthcare said: "The demand for adult mental health beds has been increasing and we wanted to be able to provide more care for people closer to home. This new ward provides an opportunity for us to do that, ultimately benefitting patients and their families.

Dr Sylvia Tang, CEO of Priory Healthcare and Part-

nerships in Care, said: "It makes absolute sense that patients are treated near to their homes and their loved ones, and, where we can work with forwardlooking Trusts like Nottinghamshire Healthcare to achieve this, we are delighted to do so.

Nottingham proudly remains in the top 150 of the THE World University **Rankings 2018**

The University of Nottingham features among the best in the world in the latest Times Higher Education World University Rankings — the definitive list of the top 1,000 universities from 77 countries.

The league table, published on 5 September 2017 — shows that Nottingham has maintained its position of 147th place, appearing among the world's elite institutions. Nottingham climbs one place to 21st in the UK, moving up a rank from 22nd last year.

Nottingham's consistent result is a reflection of the

Nottingham's consistent result is a reflection of the ground-breaking research, student and academic talent, and world-class teaching it continues to deliver. This achievement also comes amid a climate of uncertainty from the risk Brexit may pose to the global performance of the UK's leading universities and challenges European institutions are facing from Asia. Even though the US continues to dominate the rankings, Chinese universities are rapidly climbing year-

on-year.
The University of Nottingham's Registrar Dr Paul Greatrix said: "Once again, the THE World University Rankings recognises Nottingham as one of the UK—and indeed the world's—top performing universities. During an uncertain and turbulent time for higher education, this is a terrific recognition for Britain's global cation, this is a terrific recognition for Britain's global university and a reflection of the University's truly international connections.'

In this 14th annual edition of the Times Higher Education's World University Rankings, the UK is home to the worlds' top two universities for the first time in the 13-year history of the table, with the University of Oxford holding onto the number one spot while the University of Cambridge has jumped from fourth to second.

Despite signs that Asia is starting to threaten the position of some of Europe's leading institutions, Phil Baty, Editorial Director, Global Rankings, THE, said: "Europe is one of the leading regions in the THE World Rankings and is now home to more than half of the top-200 spots (101 compared to 99 last year). Europe will need to work hard to ensure in can sustain its performance in future years.









University of Nottingham's Professor Sir Martyn Poliakoff CBE FRS, has been elected a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering for his pioneering work in supercritical fluids which was judged "to combine engineering and chemistry in a highly imaginative way." 

A historic brewery is being given a new lease of life as works start on a major housing development at the old Hardy and Hansons site in the heart of Kimberley.

Acting on behalf of house builder Fairgrove Homes, Nelsons Solicitors has completed the purchase of Phase One of the site, which has planning permission for 25 new build homes and five conversions off the Hardy Street access.

Contracts on the purchase of the balance of the site have also been exchanged, which will lead to the refurbishment and conversion of the old tower and maltings buildings, and the construction of many more new homes for Kimberley.

Originally built in the 1800s, the Kimberley brewery was a major employer in Nottingham, but was sold in 2006, and since abandoned in 2011.

Mary Gharmount, associate and commercial property solicitor at Nelsons, said: "We have been working on this project since October 2016, and have arranged the site purchase, assisted with funding, infrastructure and site set up. We will also be managing the sales of

the planned properties

"This significant development has been particularly challenging, due to the historic nature of the site and complexities surrounding applications for converting buildings in conservation areas. But a suitable agreement for Fairgrove Homes and the local authority has been reached and we think the planned properties will make excellent use of the derelict site."

The 30 planned properties in the initial phase will feature a mix of houses and cot-

A phobia is a type of anxiety disorder. It is an extreme form of fear or anxiety triggered by a particular situation (such as going outside) or object (such as spiders), even when there is no danger. For example, you may know that it is safe to be out on a balcony in a high-rise block, but feel terrified to go out on it or even enjoy the view from behind the windows inside the building. Likewise, you may know that a spider isn't poisonous or that it won't bite you, but this still doesn't reduce your anxiety. A Ray of Hope for People with AM

Age-related macular degeneration (AMD) is a painless eye condition that causes you to lose central vision, usually in both eyes. AMD currently affects more than 600,000 people in the UK and is the leading cause of vision loss. By 2020, it's predicted almost 700,000 people will have late-stage AMD in the UK, leaving them legally blind. The condition is most common in people over the age of 50. It's estimated 1 in every 10 people over 65 have some degree of AMD. It is almost an inevitable part of the ageing process.

part of the ageing process. Central vision is what you see when you focus straight ahead. In AMD, this vision becomes increasingly blurred, which means:

- reading becomes difficult
- colours appear less vibrantpeople's faces are difficult to recognise This sight loss usually happens gradually over time, although it can sometimes be rapid.

times be rapid.
Sadly there is little that can be done to arrest the progression of the AMD and the vision goes steadily downhill.
Eventually some people are left with a scar at the back of the eye which detects no light and therefore the central vision is simply non-existent, resulting in a significant reduction in quality of life. People with AMD often have a co-existent cataract and they often undergo cataract surgery in the hope of improving their vision.

ing their vision.

In normal cataract surgery we put a lens (an intraocular lens or IOL) into the eye that is designed to focus light accurately onto the centre of the macula. If this area of retina is already






New developments have given some hope for patients with AMD who are desperate for some restoration of sight. There is hope now in the form of newly developed lenses which can be implant-ed at the time of cataract surgery or even if previous cataract surgery been undertaken.

The new lenses improve vision by causing a magnification effect. Rather than focussing the light on the scar at the back of the eye they magnify the image up to bridge over the scar and use areas of retina that still work. Another form of lens uses wavefront technology to spread the incoming image over the whole macula rather than a small portion, therefore bridging over areas of affected macula. The latter lens can also future proof vision as if a small portion of the meanly wavesnet the rest portion of the macula worsens the rest can compensate and preserve function-

Sadly a cure is not possible but with modern surgery and cutting edge lens-es some degree of functional vision, and therefore quality of life restoration, can be achieved.

Specialised multivitamins, stopping smoking and a healthy diet will all help reduce the progression of AMD. Regular eye checks will detect signs early and if the worst happens and central vision is lost then there is a hope that future technology will hold the answer to restoring vision.


