Nottingham Locked Out Of House-Building Plans

The Government is locking Nottingham City Council out of its plans for more council house building.

The Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government James Brokenshire has announced £1bn of additional funding for house-building - but has overwhelmingly made this available to councils in the south of the country. Mr Brokenshire has said he wants "to

building" - something the City Council is keen to be part of. But he has restricted it to councils where private rents outstrip social rents by at least £50 a week. This limits eligibility to bid for the funding to 165 councils – the vast majority of which are Conservative-controlled authorities

in the south of the country.

Some of the councils that have been granted the flexibility to bid for the borrowing allocation are the wealthiest in the country; many do not have any council houses anymore and are unlikely to

Digital delegates deliver £15,000 boost for city's homeless

Delegates at a landmark conference in Nottingham have raised more than £15,000 to support local homeless people.

The Nottingham Digital Summit was organised by Hallam, the award-winning Nottingham-based digital marketing






A Fairytale Retold

Fresh Insight into Boots Site Plans

Further plans for one of Nottingham's most significant development sites were revealed on 11 July by Conygar Investment Company plc, at a breakfast event hosted by Invest in Nottingham.

The event saw more than 70 influential professionals from businesses across the East Midlands come together to hear about the plans for a brand new mixed-use scheme on the former Boots Island site, which were submitted in June.

Held at the Jurys Inn overlooking the redevelop-

ment site, attendees were given an insight into the make-up of the proposed scheme and shown the latest artist's impressions of how it will look upon completion.

Christopher Ware of Conygar Investment Company plc – which purchased the site in 2016, said: "It was great to see so many people attend the breakfast, from key business owners to the city's stakeholders. This summer the National Justice Museum presents SUPERHEROES, a new exhibition which examines the rise of superheroes in popular cul-

ture. Themes include the role of superheroes in the fight against crime, how villains are portrayed, the representation of superheroes in children's literature and TV and what happens when superheroes act as both judge and jury – should they be policed too? The exhibition also explores how in the on-going fight for justice, super-

heroes can provide a positive message of diversity, showing that whatever your background, everyone can be a hero.

Notts School to Make Big Saving **by Changing its Lightbulbs**

A Nottingham high school is due to save more than £320,000 over the next 15 years just by changing its lightbulbs, thanks to renewable energy company Greenio. Trinity Catholic School has had a full LED lighting system installed both internally and externally at its site in Beechdale Road. The 1.350 LED project, which has just completed its second phase. will begin to offer savings of more than 150,000kg of carbon dioxide per year - the equivalent of over 200 trees. Changing the external lights at the school also improves

"Since the first installation of the LED lights six months ago, we've already seen the energy bills come down. The lighting has much improved work spaces and we expect to save hours of time changing light bulbs."

Anna Wooster. managing director of Greenio, said: "Having worked with many schools across the country it was a blessing to work closely with Steve Manderson and his team, who were accommodating, understanding and driven to turn this school into a sustainable future proofing hub. The fact the school has now gone for phase 2 is really special.

'The school now has more money to spend on learning and providing a better education for pupils. Some schools have bought new equipment such as laptops and books, whereas others have invested in their staff development and even hired extra members of staff.

Greenio, which was set up in 2013 and is based in Sleaford, Lincolnshire, has been involved in dozens of educational projects.

Anna added: "You'd think having to change thousands of lightbulbs would cause some disruption, but no learning is interrupted. Some schools prefer it to take place during the holidays, however we're happy to work around the school - working late outof-hours shifts to ensure the smoothest transition."

A terminally-ill, Derbyshire woman is choosing to spend her last few months of life continuing to campaign to local businesses to provide greater security for terminally ill workers so they cannot be dismissed as a result of their condition.

Jacci Woodcock, 60, from Milford, Derbyshire, was forced out of her job as an area sales manager three years ago after being

diagnosed with terminal breast cancer.

With the support of her Union and her local MP, Pauline Latham, Jacci started the Dying to Work campaign which has since seen hundreds of employers nationwide sign up to its voluntary charter to prevent cases like Jacci's happening in the future.

Jacci explained more: "When I found myself in the position of

being told I was terminally ill. I carried on working - it never entered my head not to carry on working - and then work started to put pressure on me to resign." Since its launch in April 2016, the Dying to Work Voluntary Charter now protects over half a million employees with larger companies such as Rolls Royce, Severn Trent Water, Royal Mail and E.On signing up. A number

of public sector bodies have also signed up including NHS trusts, the Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Services and Derbyshire County Council. The project aims to normalise dying and help people make more informed choices at the end of life. The project encourages corporate businesses to sign up to the Charter and consider how they, as employers, support someone who is diagnosed with a life limiting illness - as well as supporting their colleagues.




