They contacted the council and local MP, Vernon Coaker at the end of 2017 asking them to support their scheme to reduce the number of single use plastics. They spoke to Councillors at the meeting to encourage them to approve the motion and become a Plastic Clever Council.

Plans are also in place for a spring clean in March with a focus on collecting plastics to go towards the Kids against Plastic target of collecting 100,000 pieces of plastic.

Leader of Gedling Bor-

ough Council, Councillor John Clarke said; "I am very proud of this motion which will be presented to councillors to make Gedling Borough Council a Plastic Clever Council. We are committed to becoming one of the first councils to reduce and eventually remove the use of single use plastics in our organisation. We also encourage our businesses and residents to reduce their use of plastic, working with campaigners like Amy and Ella, who are doing a fantastic job of raising awareness of this very

A Plastic Clever Council

Councillors pledged to stop the use of single use plastics in the borough at a Full Council meeting on 31 January.

Councillors from Gedling Borough Council presented a motion at Full Council on 31 January to become one of the first Plastic Clever Councils in the country supported by a speech to Councillors from local children Amy and Ella Meek, who founded Kids against Plastic, a campaign launched to reduce the damage to our planet caused by unnecessary plastic.

The motion set out a number of initiatives to phase out the use of single use plastics in council owned buildings including leisure centres, community centres and the civic centre. Some of the initiatives set out in the motion include:

- Phasing out (with a view to ending) all sales of single plastic use bottles in Gedling Borough Council owned buildings.
- Phasing out the use of single use plastic products starting with disposable cups, cutlery and drinking straws in all council buildings.
- Replacing single use plastic cups with reusable deposit scheme cups at all council run events including the Arnold
 - Carnival. Launch an annual plastic free challenge to encourage councillors, employ-




ees, residents, organisations and businesses in the borough to reduce the use of plastic. Promoting the Kids against

Plastic campaign through the council's waste services lorries and other communications channels, to raise awareness of the work they are doing to reduce single

use plastic.

A strategy will also be created by officers to encourage the borough's institutions, businesses and residents to adopt similar measures.

Amy and Ella Meek launched the Kids Against Plastic scheme in 2015 with a tar-get to collect 100,000 pieces of plastic after learning the



1 New music festival smashes target to raise £100,000





Doctor's generous donation will benefit women's charity



A successful forensic psychologist has donated £1,000 worth of clothes and toiletries to a charity that helps women get back on their feet following their release from prison.

Dr Ruth Tully, 35, director of Nottingham based Tully Forensic Psychology Ltd, donated bags of clothes and toiletries to the Women's Service, part of Lincolnshire Action Trust. The

organisation supports vulnerable women involved in the criminal justice system, who often find themselves with nothing.

Dr Tully, said: "Many of these women find themselves having to choose between feeding their baby and buying tampons. Some of them have substance misuse problems and face adversity on their release from

prison."

Lincolnshire Action Trust works with a variety of agencies within the criminal justice system to reduce re-offending by working with offenders to address some of the issues and challenges which have resulted in their sentence. The Women's Service, which was formed a year ago, also supports the families of women who have been

in prison.

Lauren Mumby, performance and development manager at the charity, said the donation drive began six months ago when they realised there was a need for it.

She said: "We started off doing dignity packs for the women and it has grown from there. People have been very generous and the women are very

grateful that people are thinking about them.

"Dr Tully is not from Lincolnshire so it is great that she has made such a big donation, she has gone above and beyond." Part of Dr Tully's work includes carrying out psychological assessments in prisons, courts, and local authority services, and she has built a great reputation in the industry for the work she has done with her clients. Her business provides independent risk and need assessments in prison parole, court proceedings, family and criminal law cases.



Our Thoughts

It's often said that what happens in London filters through to other areas of the U.K. A study by property firm Zoopla suggests that the London rental market showed a 2.6% decline on average agreed rents in during a recent month, a trend which is also shown in 5 out of 12 U.K. regions. East Midlands average rents rose in 2017, up 2.8% on 2016.

There is currently very high demand for rental properties. In Nottinghamshire tenants are competing for limited rental stock. The situation is exacerbated by the changing nature of this generation of renters. No longer the temporary territory of young people on the road to home ownership, renting is becoming popular across the generations and with families as well as single people and couples.

The market is also witnessing a demand for rental properties with higher specifications a demand which is currently cutting across the demographic of renters. This demand, coupled with a shortage of stock will, according to Adam Kingswood of Kingswood Residential Investment Management continue to keep the Nottinghamshire rental market buoyant and thus will buck the downward decline in other regions.

Adam comments: "The London market has been overheated for some time as rental prices relative to incomes are staggeringly high for ordinary people. The average rental price in the capital is £1524 compared with a UK average of £908 and an East Midlands average of £614."

"However, where the Nottingham market is becoming somewhat like London is the level of demand. We are seeing multiple applications for each property and I predict that we will soon see sealed bids being used as a fair way of selecting tenants. This is a practice used by London letting agencies for some time." We very often receive multiple tenancy applications for one property from extremely similar applicants leaving our landlord client with very little or nothing to differentite when deciding which party to proceed with.

A fairer system? The system of sealed bids may be fairer to all parties in a busy rental market. If introduced, the practice would represent a major shift in Nottinghamshire where the market is not used to the process. For tenants, it may seem that the process of sealed bids is a system to extract more rental whereas in fact it's a process that helps to prevent gazumping and makes the system fairer which benefits the tenant and the landlord.

Tinnitus is a perception of sound in the head and/or the ear that has no external source. This is sometimes described as a buzzing, hissing, whistling or ringing in the ear. It can be intermittent or constant and can vary in volume or intensity. Sometimes it can even be a piece of music that is heard, often described as a 'musical hallucination'. Others experience it as beating in time with their heart; this is

It is very hard to say what causes tinnitus; it's is not a disease in and of itself, but often occurs where there are other underlying conditions, to which it can be linked, e.g., hearing loss, exposure to loud noise, anxiety or stress, earwax, head injuries, etc.

There is no single treatment for tinnitus that works for everyone. If an underlying cause can be found, treating this might help - e.g. removing earwax. If specific causes cannot be identified, then things like sound therapy, counseling,

Why are regular eye tests (sight tests) so important?

It's easy to neglect your eyes because they rarely hurt when there's a problem.

Having an eye test won't just tell you if you need new glasses or a change of prescription – it's also an important eye

health check.
It can spot many general health prob-lems and early signs of eye conditions before you're aware of any symp-toms, many of which can be treated if found early enough.

How often should I have an eye test?

Optometrists recommend that most people have an eye test about every two years. People over 40 and people from black or minority ethnic groups may need sight tests more often.

What should I do if I notice a change in my

sight?

Visit your optician or GP if you're concerned about any aspect of your vision at any time.

What about my child's sight?

Children do not usually complain about their sight, but may show signs of not being able to see properly.

Things to look out for include sitting close to the TV, holding objects very close to their face, blinking a lot, eye rubbing, or one eye turning in or out.

If your child is having any sort of sight problems, take them to an optometrist for further investigation.

Children don't have to be able to read letters to have their eyes examined. Like adults, children should have regular eye checks around every two years.

Protect your eyes from the sun

Never look at the sun directly, even when something exciting is happening, such as an eclipse. Doing so

to your eyesight and even lead to blindness. Several studies also suggest sunlight exposure is a risk factor for cataracts. Look for glasses carrying the CE mark or the British Standard


